

Westport introduces Solar de Santana to the National Prize of Urban Rehabilitation

Westport International introduces the rehabilitation and requalification of the historical building Solar de Santana, located in Mártires da Pátria, in Lisbon.

The Solar de Santana enterprise is the result of an intervention that restructured the building at a technical and spatial level, including the maintenance, preservation and recovery of the whole integrated and identity heritage. The rehabilitation of the old Solar resulted in 20 fractions with 1 to 5 bedroom apartments, terraced houses, all of them defined by the current comfort and convenience requirements, without neglecting highly valuable historical elements, such as its tile heritage.

Solar de Santana is born from a project by Rui Pinto Gonçalves and Ecociaf.

Applications are open until the 8th of March

The applications for the National Prize of Urban Rehabilitation 2021 are open until the 8th of March. In the 2021 edition, rehabilitation interventions concluded between January 1st 2019 and December 31st 2020 can apply, as long as they had not been included in previous editions.

The best interventions will be divided into 10 categories, including: Lisbon City, Porto City, Social Impact, Residential, Tourism, Commerce and Services, Energetic Efficiency, Structural Rehabilitation, Restoration and Intervention below 1.000 m2.
